## **HISTORY 12 - EXIT INTERVIEWS**

During the interview I will be looking for how much knowledge you gained throughout the course, but also your growth in the area of Critical Thinking.

# Unit 1 - Treaty of Versailles

- 1. How did the goals of the allied nations at the Paris Peace Conference lead to future conflicts in the 20<sup>th</sup> century?
- 2. Which countries were born out of the idea of self-determination set forth by President Wilson in his 14-points? How would these new countries lead to problems in Europe during the 1930's?
- 3. How did the Treaty of Versailles and the mandate system lead to problems in the Middle East in the 1940's?

### Unit 2 - Rise of Communism in the USSR

- 1. Explain how the Soviet Union changed their economy from being based upon communism to being based upon some capitalist ideas between 1918 and 1939.
- 2. What was the Cult of Stalin and how did this idea help solidify his power in the Soviet Union?

## Unit 3 - USA Road to War

- 1. What is isolationism, and was the US able to consistently follow this policy during the Interwar Period?
- 2. What was a cause of the Great Depression and how did FDR try to deal with this issue?

#### Unit 4 - Rise of Fascism

- 1. What is the idea of "Cult of Personality" and how did Hitler or Mussolini use this to gain power and influence in Europe?
- 2. During what event did Hitler try to seize power illegally in 1923?
- 3. How did the Reichstag Fire allow Hitler to consolidate his power in Germany?
- 4. Name one of Hitler's Henchmen and explain what war crime he was responsible for.

### Unit 5 - WWII

- 1. How was WWII a war based upon discrimination?
- 2. Hitler was fighting two wars, both against the allied countries and people he considered "undesirable", what evidence is there that Hitler was more concerned with the latter by 1945?
- 3. What was one of Hitler's mistakes during WWII and why?
- 4. Name one of the turning point battles during WWII and explain how this battle helped to turn the tide of the war for the allies.
- 5. What were some of the war crimes that the allies perpetrated during WWII?

#### Unit 6 - Cold War

- 1. To what extent was the Cold War about image?
- 2. What was the Domino Theory, and how did President Truman try to deal with it?
- 3. What is a client war and how does the Korean War fit into this category during the Cold War?
- 4. What was the Red Scare and who was seen as the face of it?
- 5. What was considered to be the climax of the Cold War and what was the result for both Kennedy and Khrushchev?

### Unit 7 - China

- 1. Was Mao good for China? Explain.
- 2. What did the Long March accomplish for Mao?
- 3. What caused the Sino-Soviet Split?

#### Unit 8 - Middle East

- 1. How did the Balfour Declaration upset both Jews and Palestinians?
- 2. What was the Zionist movement and how did it lead to the successful creation of the state of Israel?
- 3. Who won the 6-Day War and why?
- 4. Why was OPEC created and what does it do?
- 5. What is the PLO and what has been some of the events they were a part of?
