

Was WWI a Period of Significant Change and Development of Canada as a Nation?

We have just finished studying Canada’s involvement in WWI and we have seen some significant things occur for Canada politically, socially, and economically. The question you must answer is this:

To what extent did Canada’s involvement in WWI change Canada politically, socially and economically?

As this is a “to what extent” question, you must show in your answer that you have considered both sides to the argument and that after careful consideration you came to the conclusion you have presented. Make sure to give reasons for why you have argued the way you have. Make sure to use knowledge you have gained of the 5 major battles, the idea of Total War and the home front, the conscription crisis, etc., to help you answer the question. Fill out the following chart to help you answer the question.
