

The Cult of Mao – Portfolio Assignment

- 3. In point-form, list the negative things Mao did for his people that did not support his image.
- 4. Finally, compare the "Cult of Mao" to that of Stalin, Hitler and Mussolini. Was he more, or less successful than his predecessors in creating a lasting, positive image for himself?
